Motorcycle marshals are escorts for the MS-150. They have been part of the MS-150 for more than 20 years. They keep riders safe and they help change flat tires and assist with other mechanical issues, and even help with crashes. They usually carry a regular bike pump which makes the tire-changing process much quicker. While they are escorting riders, they have flashing lights. While most motorcycles marshals are not official law enforcement, they act as a deterrent to potentially aggressive drivers.

Their official mission is stated on their web page: It is to provide "Service, Safety and Communication" during the rides sanctioned by the National MS Society of Texas.
